## LETTER OF INTENT / THANKS



### The letter should include the following:

- 1. It should be addressed to Fr. Paul and the Parishioners of St. Luke.
  - 2. The request should be stated in great humility.
  - 3. The request should be accompanied by an explanation of why you are prepared to receive the sacrament, and the candidate should state his/her desire to be confirmed.

Each student is required to write a letter to Fr. Paul formally requesting the Sacrament of Confirmation. Use the attached worksheet to help create a rough draft for the letter. Bring the rough draft to class the week of March 24<sup>th</sup> and use it to write your final letter. Final letters will be handwritten and turned in at a later time. The confirmation office will then be posting your letters on the walls of the Education hallway.

### **CANDIDATE INFORMATION**

### The letter should include a brief explanation of the following:

- Favorite topics studied during preparation;
- A short explanation why you chose your Confirmation Saint;
- Types of Christian service accomplished (service hours);
- Some of your personal comments/thoughts about your faith;
- How you plan to live out your faith after Confirmation.

### To help You Prepare:

To help you prepare to write this letter, think about the topics you've covered in classes or resources that you've used over the last few years. Review your study guide and materials to remind you of what you've covered in your faith journey. It is not necessary to list everything you have studied; three or four examples of study topics would suffice. Be sure to choose topics that interested you greatly, or ones that really impacted you.

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**Note to Candidate:** Use this sample outline as a guide to help you in writing your *Letter of Intent* to Fr. Paul and the parishioners of St. Luke.

- The Letter will be handwritten. Your 1st Draft can be typed, you will be expected and required to handwrite the final version.
- You should include:
  - Your desire to be confirmed;
  - Reasons why you feel you are ready to be confirmed;
  - Topics that you've covered that impacted and/or stuck with you;
  - How Confirmation will impact or change your life;
  - How you will use your Gifts of the Holy Spirit
